The exuberance of youth is still perceptible. Blueberry, blackberry, black cherry, black plum, and violet confirm it.

Cinnamon, cloves, and chocolate subtly underscore the ensemble. Fig, date, prune, walnut, and hazelnut indicate a work gaining in wisdom as mint refreshes the whole in a unique way.

The lively acidity, moderate alcohol, and tannins refining over decades find a perfect balance. The silky texture stands out as a signature. Finally, fruits and flowers delicately settle over time.
